### Main Gate

- Have a valid Government Issued Photo ID (drivers license, passport, etc.) ready for inspection by Security Officers
- Proceed to visitor parking at Gate F and follow the Security Officer's guidance on parking
- Enter the Building 200 Lobby to check-in with Lobby Receptionist with your valid Government Issued Photo ID (drivers license, passport, etc) to receive a visitor badge and meet your escort
  - All Foreign Nationals must check in with their Passport

### Foreign National Visitors

All Foreign Nationals must check into Building 200 Lobby. Please ensure that your passport and any supporting documentation is available for review. Once badged, you must be escorted inside the building at all times. If you will attend a classified visit, a government-to-government Foreign Visit Request (FVR) must be on file. This can take 30+ days to process.

### Facility Guidelines

- Recording audio or video (to include cell phones with recording capability) on company property is prohibited
- Taking pictures (to include with cell phone cameras) on company property (inside or outside) is prohibited
- Personally owned electronic devices cannot be used to process or store Lockheed Martin information, or to connect to Lockheed Martin computer systems, data networks or telephone systems
- Hands-free devices are required for cell phone use while driving on company property
- Guests must display their visitor badge at all times
- Guests are required to stay with their escorts at all times
- Lockheed Martin Aeronautics is a tobacco free facility

### **Note regarding Dash Cameras, Go Pros and similar:**

Factory installed cameras, if possible, should be disabled prior to arriving to the LM Aero facility. After market installed cameras must be disabled, shutoff, and/or covered prior to arriving to the LM Aero facility. Any image, video, and/or audio recorded while onsite is prohibited from being used on any and all platforms.

## Security

### Items Prohibited at Lockheed Martin Aero Fort Worth

- Firearms/weapons/various dangerous devices, in order to maintain a safe and respectful workplace and applicable state statutes
- Any knife that would be unlawful to carry under applicable state law or federal law, including all non-folding knives, regardless of length, and all folding knives.
- All controlled dangerous substances or prohibited drug paraphernalia (based on federal law, not local or state law)
- All explosive devices, chemical compound/mixture, or fireworks
- Alcoholic beverages
- Gambling equipment/paraphernalia
- Any device designed to intercept aural or electronic communications or conduct electronic surveillance (excluding cellular telephones).
- Pornographic/sexually explicit material
- Use of any tobacco products and/or vapes

### Controlled Items

Controlled items are allowed on-site. Visitors are prohibited from using audio, video or still imaging functions of these items while on-site. However, controlled items are prohibited from being introduced into any DoD closed and restricted area or any areas so designated by the visitor's host.

- Cell phones
- Cameras (still and video)
- Smartphones
- Video recorders and two-way pagers

Security reserves the authority to search all persons, vehicles and property. The purpose of such inspections is to comply with government requirements, and protect against sabotage, espionage, and other illegal or unauthorized activities.



## Visitor Information (cont.)

### Facility Tours

Tours are not approved for all visits. Your visit host will communicate if a tour is approved and what guidelines apply.

### Visit with an Approved Tour

Most approved tours are via golf cart with a tour guide. In general, the visitors will not have to get off the golf cart; however, in some instances there may be a need. In those cases, if going into a space that is designated as a FOD area there will be some extra guidelines to follow.

#### FOD Guideline Examples:

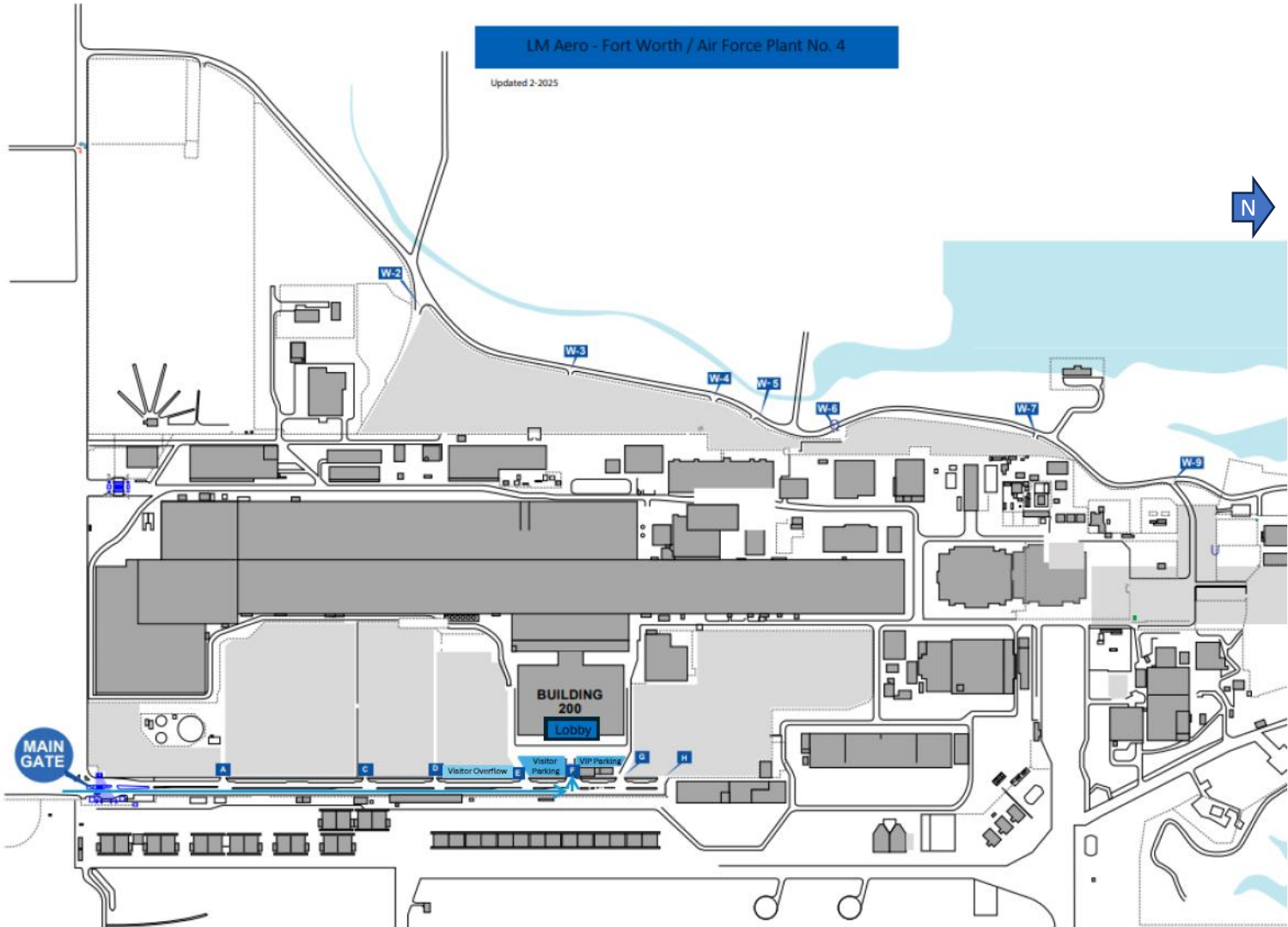
- Visitors must be escorted by a Lockheed Martin employee when entering a FOD Area
- Visitors must comply with all FOD procedures, to include but not limited to:
  - A FOD personal pack will be provided to visitors and the following are examples on what will be placed in those packs
    - Visitor badge
    - Loose contents in all pockets
    - Remove all jewelry except:
      - Medical alert jewelry
      - Personal health monitoring devices (*pedometers, Fitbit, etc.*)
      - Wristwatches

### Tour Attire Guidelines

- Closed toe, closed heel, flat shoes are required for all tour participants
- Slacks are recommended for all tour participants

NOTE: ALL visitors --except U.S. Government and U.S. Contractor representatives visiting on official business-- will be prohibited from taking electronic devices (cell phones, iPads, etc.) into production or production related, non-office areas (factory floors, manufacturing areas, flight line) when conducting business or on an approved tour. The LM host/escort will be responsible for ensuring visitors are aware of this prohibition in advance of the visit and they are also responsible for providing the visitors with options on the handling of their electronic device (leave in vehicle, leave in office area, host/escort holds) when the visitor arrives at our facilities. Security Officers will not retain electronic devices at facility entrances.

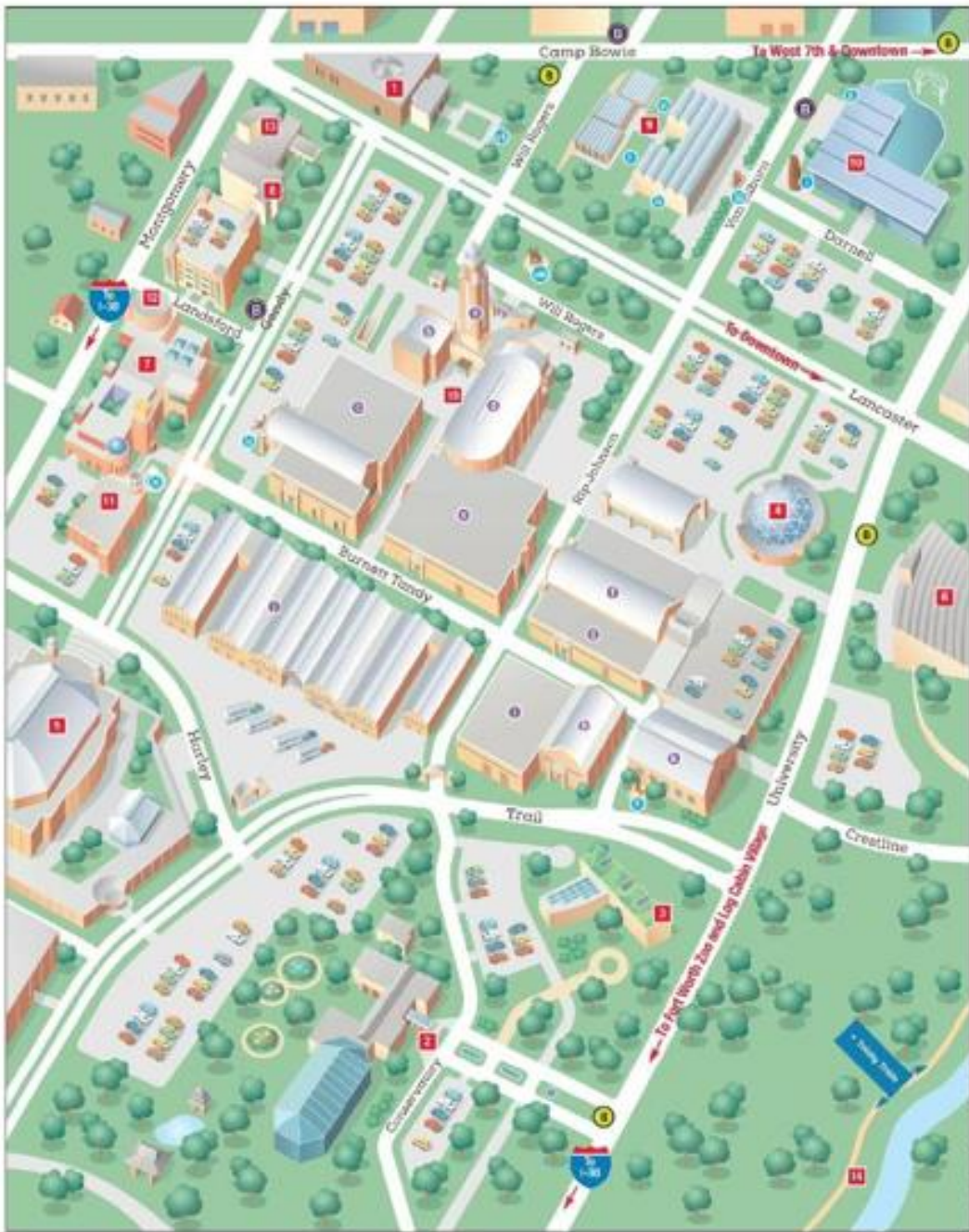

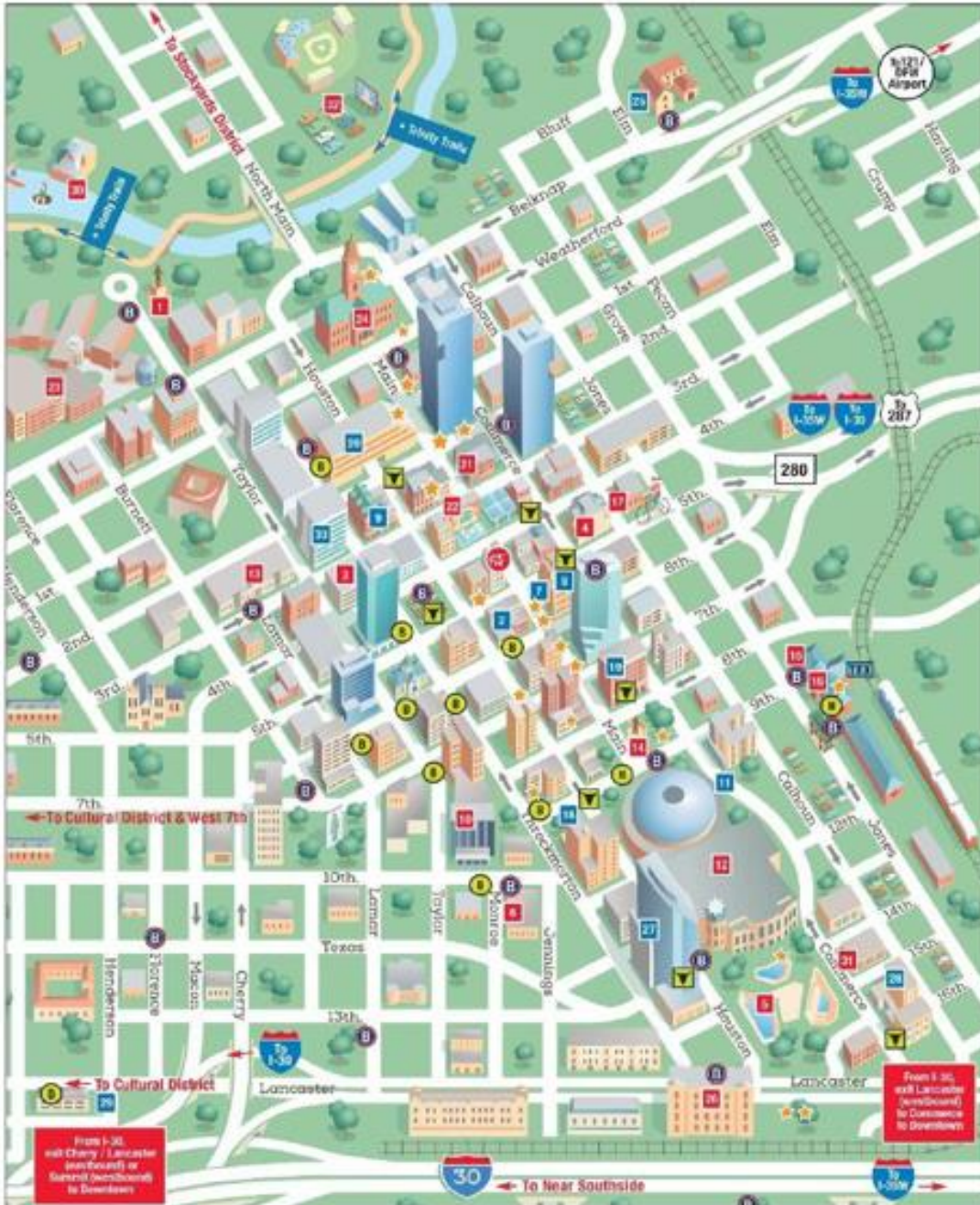

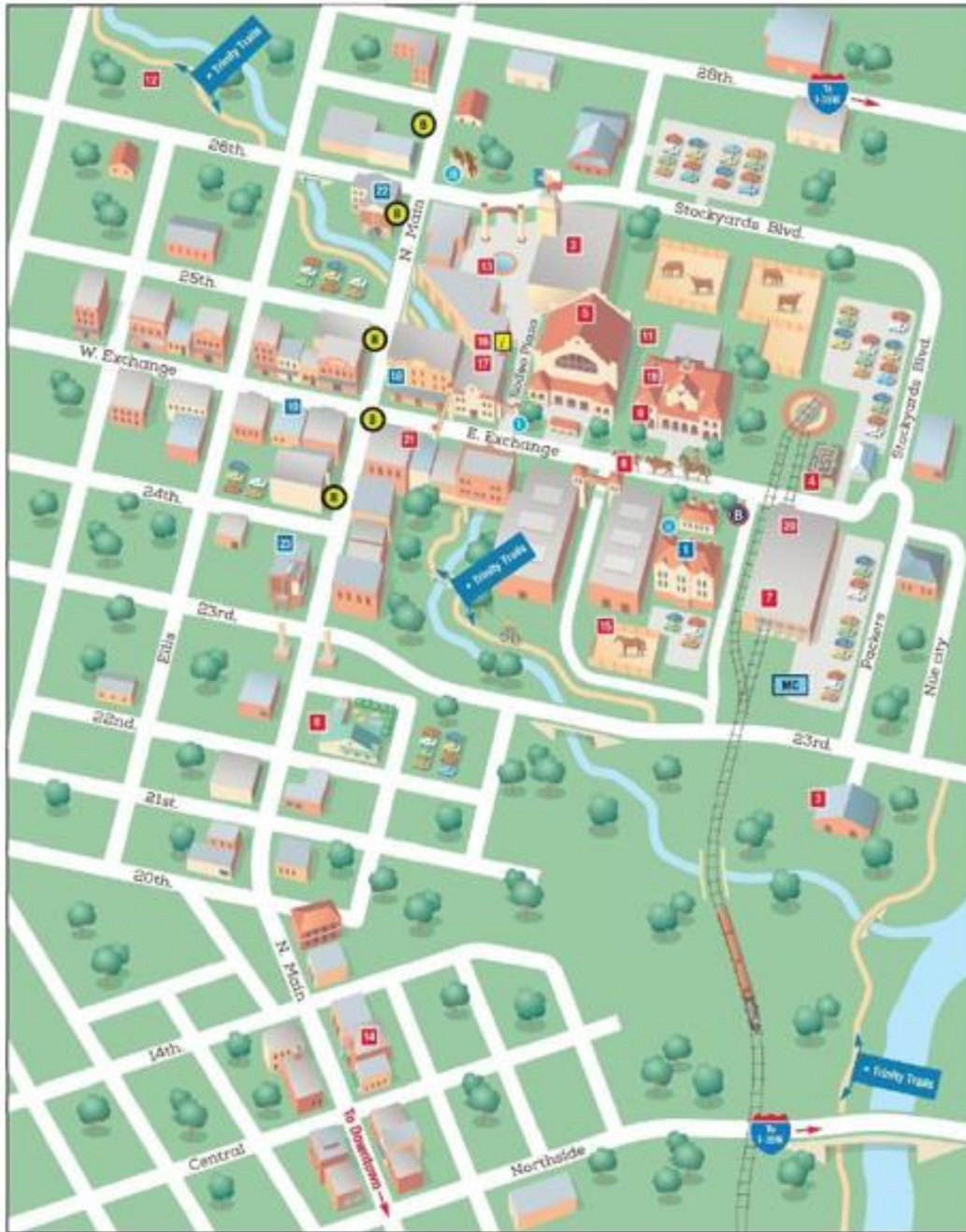
